

## **Script to Accompany 6-Utah's Online Library PowerPoint:**

*(Numbers correspond to slide numbers.)*

Slide 1. What is the #1 Internet site for Utah students to find trusted information?

Slide 2. Utah's Online Library of course! <https://onlinelibrary.uen.org/> is the Internet address. The address and the logo tell us that this site is for students in Utah schools.

Slide 3. Utah's Online Library is for all Utah students. It is available from schools and public libraries. We can reach Utah's Online Library from home computers using a login name and password. The password changes every summer. The password for this year is \_\_\_\_\_. (Have the students write the password on their Utah's Online Library bookmarks.) Let's take a look at some of the databases: First: CultureGrams.

Slide 4. Notice all the information available in this database: Where would you go to find information for kids on Zimbabwe in Africa? Let's try the Kids Edition.

Slide 5. OK, here's Africa; now let's find Zimbabwe

Slide 6. There it is, now let's see what we can learn about Zimbabwe.

Slide 7. Name some of the types of information on Zimbabwe. Good, now let's go back to the Utah's Online Library home page to see what else we can find.

Slide 8. Let's take a look at Gale in Context Elementary School.

Slide 9. Let's focus on science for this database. Type "astronomy" in the textbox and click "Search."

Slide 10. Pictures? Scroll down to the Pictures section, choose any of the eclipse pictures.

Slide 11. OK, but we want to look at a larger version of the picture, so we click on the picture.

Slide 12. You can access further information about Astronomy by clicking on the links above the pictures. Or check out the links at the bottom of the page for more topics related to Astronomy. Isn't this a great database! Back to Utah's Online Library.

Slide 13. Our final database for today is Soundzaboud. Here we find music and sound effects for presentations.

Slide 14. The music and sounds on this site are free for schools to use. Let's do a search on Sound Effects by typing "Sound Effects" in the search bar.

Slide 15. Notice all the sounds on the list. Let's see if we can find a sound effect for wind. Type the word in the search box, and click "search."

Slide 16. There it is at the top of the list. Now let's see how it sounds. I'm sure you can see how sounds can make your presentations more effective. Please always remember to use this site with courtesy at school.

Slide 17. Now everyone is sure of the answer to this question. What is the #1 Internet site for Utah students to find trusted information?

Slide 18. Utah's Online Library of course! Ask your teacher if you can do a research project using Utah's Online Library. Be sure to take the bookmark home to remind you how to access Utah's Online Library from your home computer, and remember that the password from home will change again next summer.
